



## Rātū 04 Hakihea 2018

*Kia ora tātou e te whānau i roto i ngā tū āhuatanga o te wā. E mihi ana ki tēnei kaupapa ā tātou e whakakotahi ana i tēnā, i tēnā o tātou i runga i te whakaaro kōtahi.*

**CALLING ALL KURA WHĀNAU MEMBERS!!** - This Saturday, 8th December, Te Wānanga o Raukawa have their graduation day. This is also the day we run one of our fundraising kai stalls. Matua Rob, along with other staff members and senior students will **not** be available that day to do the mahi therefore our whānau need to prepare to run the stall, prepare the food (shell mussels, make and cook fry bread etc) and run everything as necessary to ensure a good fundraising stall. The tari will provide the float. The kura will provide the ingredients. The whānau will provide the man-power. The menu is set so you will only need to help prepare, set up site & gazebos/tables, cook and sell. These jobs can be rotated amongst whānau however, it is up to the kura whānau to do this, **not the kura staff**. Some whānau are making kai in their own time as they will be unavailable on the day (ie: choppy). Please let Jalaine Tahiwī know if you are available and for which days/times. This is a fundraiser that contributes to keeping the kura costs down for your whānau each year. Please do your part as we are not expecting staff to run it again as they have every other year.

**Te Kura o Kauwhata Activity Day, Friday 7th December** - Our entire kura have been invited to Te Kura o Kauwhata to participate in an activity day. Last year, we hosted this awesome day - *this year*, our Kauwhata whānau are reciprocating and will be hosting us.

- Bus run will be as normal from Levin-Otaki in the morning
- We will then depart from WRM at 9.20am and head to Te Kura o Kauwhata
- At the end of the day, we will depart Te Kura o Kauwhata at 2.00pm
- We will return Levin students to Te Takere, Levin then carry on back to Otaki



- Remaining students will return to WRM by approximately 3.30pm
- There will be no afternoon bus from Otaki to Levin that day

**Kākahu hākinakina/Kura Sport Uniforms** - If you have any kura sport uniforms at your home, please return them to kura immediately!

**Pōtae** - These are available in the tari and include wide brimmed hats, bucket hats and caps - all cost \$20 and include student's name embroidered on the pōtae.

**Pōtae are compulsory from now on** - students will not be permitted outside without one. If you are waiting to have one embroidered, please send your tamaiti along with a pōtae until the embroidered kura one is returned with their name on it.

**Pūrongo** - Pūrongo will be available to be uplifted during the last week of kura. We **will not** be sending pūrongo home unless **whānau make contact with their child's classroom kaiako**.

**Subway** - Subway is available this week. Please have your orders in to us by 2.00pm Thursday afternoon. Subway sandwiches will be delivered on Friday at lunchtime. Cash only please.

**Moheni/ Magazines** - If you have any magazines that you no longer want can you send them in for kura teina please?

**Whānau Debts** - We have been following a process of contacting whānau who have outstanding debts that are of concern:

1. request payment towards outstandings
2. establishment of automatic payments
3. or adjusting the amount received by kura to more realistic amount

We have had some positive results from many whānau and then no result from a few

We have set up an client account with Baycorp - who, in need will assist us with recovery of longstanding debts. We intend to use their services from 1st November 2018.
